ABSTRACT GUIDELINES:

The abstract should be in English using MS word (Single space; Font Cambria; Font size- 12) and should not exceed 350 words.

The abstracts must contain title of the paper, name(s) of author(s) followed by their affiliation and e-mail. The name of presenting author should be underline

ORAL PRESENTATION GUIDELINES:

- Oral presentation with PowerPoint
- Time limit: 5-7 minutes
- Question & answer session by judges: 2-3 minutes
- Maximum number of slides: 12
- Font: Times New Roman
- All the members of a team may choose to speak but the time limit should be adhered to.
- The softcopy of the presentation should be sent to the e-mail ID before the deadline.
- The template for presentation will be sent.

POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES:

- Poster displays will be limited to one side of the 4 foot by 8-foot tack board.
- **The poster size must be 60 cm (width) by 90 cm (height)- Portrait.**
- The poster should contain maximum of 650 words with visual elements.
- **Light green accent 6 is recommended for Background of the poster.**
- The font size must be:

Body text	Times New Roman -24 [OPTIONAL]
Figure caption	Arial-43

- Make sure the directional flow of information is clear with Introduction, materials and method, results and discussion, conclusion and references as per standard format.
- The participant must hand - carry your poster to the conference. Costs associated with creating the poster will be the responsibility of the authors.
- Push pins or thumb tags will be provided by the organizers to mount your posters.
- The poster presenter must be present at the assigned hall during the designated time.
